Digital language support program for German as a second language Aus Liebe zum Menschen.

What is DigiDaZ?

- ❖ DigiDaZ is a language support program for children whose first language is not German.
- The goal is to improve your child's German skills.
- ❖ The language course takes place via the online platforms Zoom and MS-Teams.
- The language course is free.
- ❖ Your child can take part in the language support program 1 to 3 times a week.
- To take part in the program, your child needs either a smartphone or a laptop.
- The course can either take place at home or school during school hours.
- The supervisory responsibilities during the online course lie with the parents when at home or with the teachers when at school.

The following rules apply when taking part in the language program:

- No disclosure of the passwords from the online platforms.
- No recordings of images or sounds from the language course.
- No publication of pictures, sounds, or video recordings of the language course.
- The camera needs to be turned on to make interaction easier.
- ❖ A quiet atmosphere with no interruptions during the course is needed.
- Punctuality is important.
- ❖ In case of technical difficulties, try contacting someone immediately.
- If the course cannot be attended, it is mandatory to cancel beforehand.
